

ISA-ASU Study Abroad Application Instructions

Make sure you've considered the following steps before moving forward:

1. Meet with your ASU study abroad advisor on campus to talk about course approval, initial paperwork required for your institution, and financial aid options.

2. [Research courses](#) and bring those descriptions to your advisor for review and pre-approval.
3. Check [ISA deadlines](#) for the program you are applying to.
4. Review the [ISA Cancellation Policy](#) and [visa requirements](#).
5. [Contact ISA](#) if you have any questions!

Please note that ASU has its own deadlines and may require that you complete your ISA program application prior to ISA's deadlines as found on ISA's website.

MEET THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Check the individual eligibility requirements for your program on our website, as they vary per program.

- **GPA¹** - Requirements range from 2.50 to 3.30
- **Foreign Language Proficiency**, if applicable
- **Academic Classification** (e.g. sophomore standing), if applicable

1. For most ISA programs, if you have a cumulative GPA that falls below the requirement, you can submit at least one academic letter of recommendation and a letter of intent for consideration into the program. Certain programs cannot consider participants whose GPA falls below their minimum requirement. Please contact your ISA Program Manager to verify GPA requirements for your program.

Step 2: Log in to the ISA Portal

- Upon receipt of your application, you will receive an initial email confirmation.
- You will then receive an email to log in to your ISA Student Portal with a username and password. *Please allow up to 2-3 business days to receive this log-in email.*
- Log in to your ISA Portal and review and complete the Application Materials and Student Details section.
- All ISA programs require the ISA Supplement and Official Transcript. Your ASU Advisor will send ISA information regarding credit transfer. You will see any additional required materials in your ISA portal.

You will be responsible for submitting all pre- and post-acceptance materials through your portal by your program deadline.
